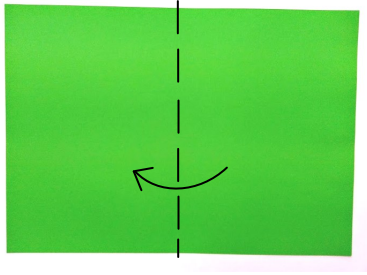
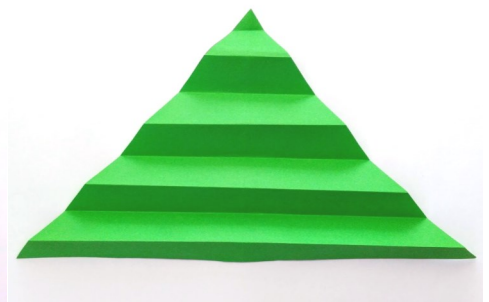
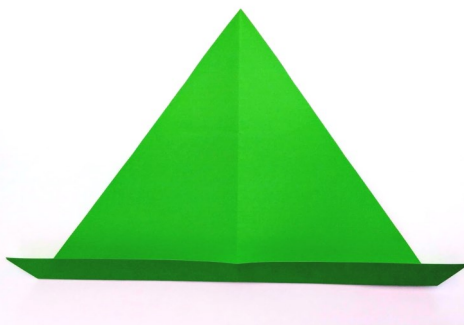
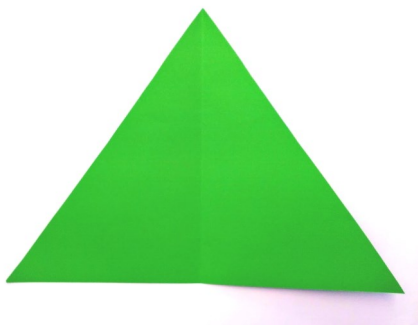
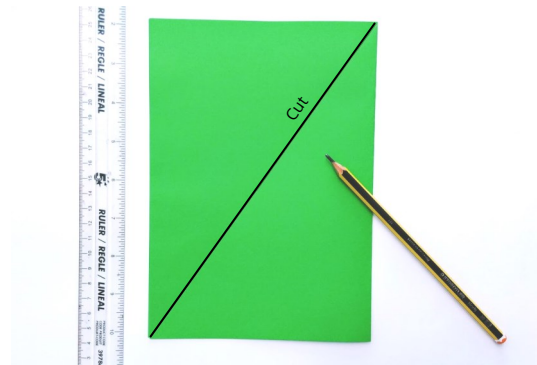


How to make a leaf sculpture

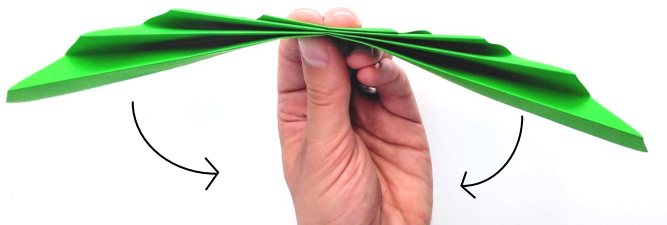


1. Take a piece of coloured paper and fold in half

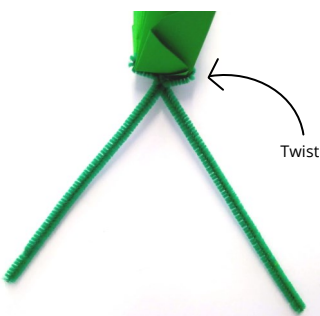
2. Draw a line from one corner to another and cut along



3. Take your triangle and fold up a strip from the bottom, then flip over and fold again. Repeat until the whole triangle is folded into a concertina



4. Pinch the concertina together in the middle and fold in half



6. Thread a pipe cleaner through the base of your leaf and twist at the top and bottom to make a stem




5. Ask an art assistant to staple the tip together
