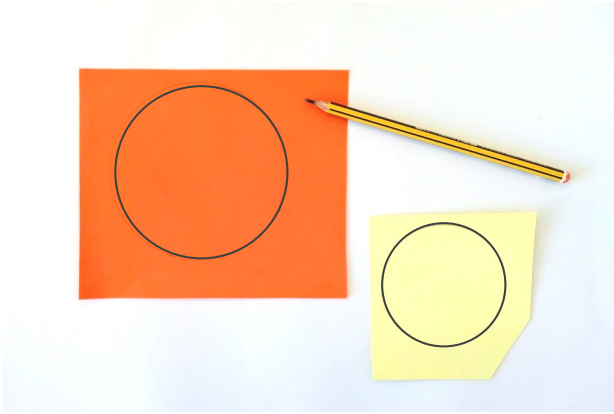


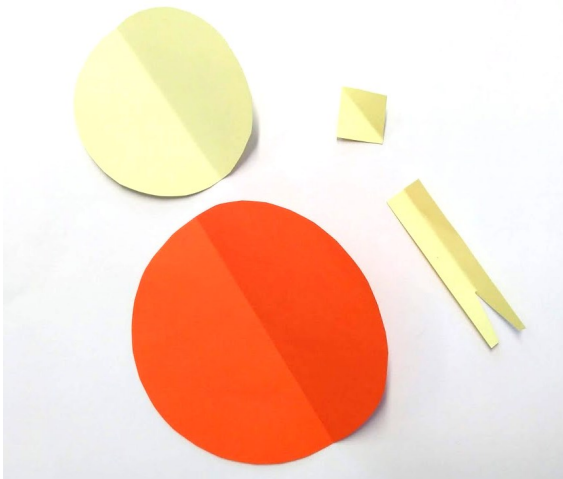
How to make a bird sculpture



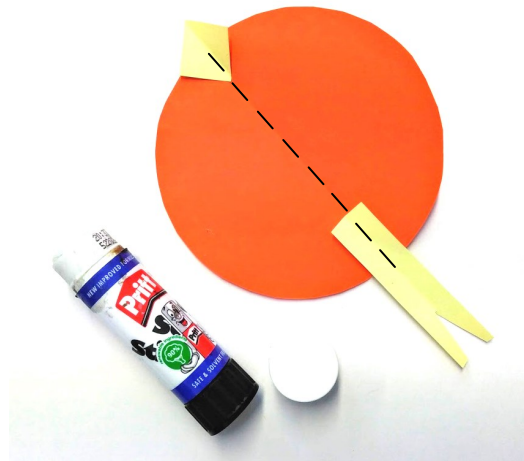
1. Take two different coloured pieces of paper and draw around the circle templates on the table to make one big circle and one small circle. Cut them out.



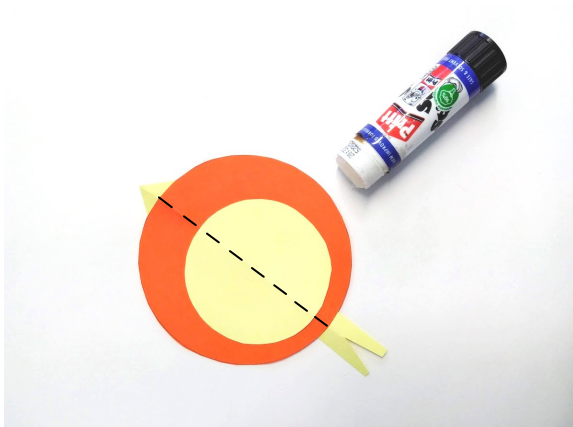
2. Cut out these two shapes to make the beak and tale, they can be whatever colours you like.



3. Fold your four shapes in half. Make sure to fold the beak in half like a diamond.



4. Stick the beak and tale to the top and bottom of the big circle following the folded line.



5. Flip it over and stick the small circle to the back making sure to follow the folds.




5. Fold your bird in half along the fold, keeping the small circle on the outside. Draw in an eye and add a stick underneath for a stand and you are done!

Your very own bird sculpture!
